

NIGHT FIRE COURSE



Low light / Night fire Handgun Course

The course curriculum covers the use of handheld and weapon mounted lights while shooting. This 4 hour class starts in the afternoon and progresses from daylight to evening to low light to night darkness scenarios. You will be taught techniques used to grip both the handgun and the light and search, room clear, and engage targets using the light and pistol simultaneously. Reloads, malfunction clearing, etc., will all be taught in conjunction with manipulating the flashlight. You will need a handgun, flashlight, 150 rounds of ammunition, ear protection, eye protection, a holster, 2 or more magazines or speed loaders, and a notebook. Cost is \$75.
